- It costs **about \$10,000 per student** to operate our school each year. This covers teacher and staff salaries, building expenses, utilities, classroom materials, curriculum, technology, and the many day-to-day costs required to provide a safe, Christ-centered learning environment.
- Because of these real operating costs, our listed tuition reflects the true expense of running the school. However, we are pursuing **EdChoice School Voucher accreditation**, and we expect to know the final approved voucher amounts between **March and June**.
- Once vouchers are applied, the cost to families would be significantly reduced:

Kindergarten: approximately **\$3,500 per year**
(about \$350 per month)

- **1st Grade:** approximately **\$4,000 per year**
(about \$400 per month)
- These lower amounts are possible because **state education vouchers help cover a large portion of the actual \$10,000 per-student cost.**
- Families would be able to apply for vouchers in **summer 2026** for the **2026–2027 school year.**
- We are committed to making Christian education both excellent and as affordable as possible for families, and vouchers are a huge blessing in helping bridge that gap.

Curriculum

Bright Christian School has adopted Purposeful Design's academic and Bible curriculum which is aligned to academic standards in all core subjects and supports the aim to provide a well-rounded education that integrates both academic excellence and spiritual growth. The program is intentionally designed to ensure students develop intellectually, morally, and socially, with an emphasis on biblical principles.

English/Language Arts: The English curriculum focuses on developing reading, writing, speaking, and listening skills. The Science of Reading is a foundational strategy with proven benefits and will be used within Bright Christian School. UFLI and Heggerty curriculum is supplemental. Biblical Christian values will be incorporated into literature selections, encouraging students to examine texts through a biblical lens, recognizing God's love especially for them, and to consider moral and ethical lessons.

Mathematics: Mathematics instruction covers foundational concepts such as number recognition, sequence, and arithmetic. The curriculum emphasizes critical thinking and problem-solving skills, providing students with the tools they need for practical applications in the world. Please anticipate discussions about the order and structure of God's creation, emphasizing how mathematics reveals patterns in nature.

Science: The science curriculum focuses on key areas like biology, chemistry, physics, and earth science. Students will learn about the natural world, scientific processes, and the principles that govern the universe. The study of science shall include discussions on the compatibility between biblical Christian faith and science, viewing the natural world as evidence of God's design and creation.

Social Studies: Social studies instruction includes history, geography, economics, and civics. The curriculum addresses different cultures, historical events, and the responsibilities of

citizenship. The curriculum will explore biblical Christian values in history, emphasizing how faith has influenced social structures and movements. Ethical and moral lessons from the Bible will be used to guide discussions on social justice and community service. Teachers aim to foster not just academic proficiency but also spiritual maturity, helping students understand how their faith intersects with every area of life. The academic standards and curriculum are designed to provide a comprehensive education, grounded in biblical Christian faith, that equips students for both academic success and spiritual growth.

Tuition & Registration

Bright Christian School is an essential ministry of Bright Christian Church, and we are deeply committed to making Christian education affordable and accessible for families in our community.

Tuition costs may be lowered in the future if additional donors come forward to support tuition assistance. At this time, our efforts are focused on the **YES Campaign**, which is raising funds for our new school building. If donors are able to contribute specifically toward reducing tuition costs, we will gladly notify families as those opportunities become available.

Currently, tuition is billed monthly at a rate of **\$350 for Kindergarten** and **\$400 for 1st Grade**, due by the 15th of each month. Families are welcome to make larger installment payments or pay in full in advance. **Supply fees have been fully covered by a private donor**, for which we are very grateful.

Our ongoing goal is to ensure Bright Christian School remains an affordable option for every family seeking a quality, faith-based education for their children.
